## Opening:

- 1. The regular meeting of the Red River Valley Amateur Radio Club was called to order at 10:10AM on February 22, 2020 at the Paris City Courtroom, by club President Steven Davoust (N5KCH).
- 2. ## Meeting:

- 1. Pledge of Allegiance was led by T. Wayne Moore.
- 2. Opening Prayer was led by Kelly Collins.
- 3. Steven Davoust called for recognition of any guests, none were in attendance but new member Larry LaMaack was introduced.
- 4. President's Remarks (if any) Steven Davoust gave some prepared remarks:
  - a. Sandi Boyd Lonnie Boyd fell and hit his head last year. He has some lingering health issues and so that, combined with all of her other obligations, has lead Sandi to consider not completing her term as club Treasurer. She has agreed to hold off on actually resigning until we work on recruiting her replacement. Please join the officers in thanking Sandi for her time and we will follow up with you next meeting.
  - b. At a couple of recent meetings NCTC has come up. The officers have spent many, many hours, getting the matter resolved. Bottom line There was some miscommunication and misunderstanding. We have taken steps to remedy the matter. All of the officers are in agreement on this matter and we consider it resolved.
  - c. We are going to a new meeting format:
    - i. We want to start clearing as much administrative stuff as possible as quickly as possible and move on to programs and "fun stuff."
    - ii. ### Program:


- 1. Phillip Beall gave an update on the governance documents update project.


### **Old Business:**

The cost is \$1.40 per \$100 of replacement cost value (minimum premium is \$20). They give as an example, if the replacement value of the equipment is \$2,000, the annual premium is \$28.
- c. It has been pointed out that we have overlooked recognizing guests at some recent meetings. We now have added a note to make sure and do that to the flow chart we started using to run the meetings beginning today.
- d. Fall Lions Club/fair organizational support (Mark it on your calendar now! Fall Fair Wednesday-Saturday and Sunday afternoon clean up September 23-27.)
