Resolution Name: Club Station WB5RDD – UHF (444.500) Repeater – NCTC – RepeaterBook Updating

Whereas the Red River Valley Amateur Radio Club (RRVARC) UHF (444.500) Repeater, its capability and utility, has varied through the years, and;

Whereas in review of how RRVARC is listed when reviewing the RepeaterBook.com listing ([click here to view](#)), our UHF repeater details are as follows: “Links: Full-time to the North Central Texas Connection (NCTC) System.” (Last updated 2018), and;

Whereas in review of how the adjacent Fannin County Amateur Radio Club (FCARC) runs their two repeaters, and reviewing the RepeaterBook.com listing ([click here to view](#)), they run their UHF repeater as follows: “Links: Full-time to the North Central Texas Connection (NCTC) System.” (Last updated 04/17/2022), and;

Whereas other RRVARC data needs updating on RepeaterBook, therefore;

Be it resolved, the RRVARC BOD directs the Club Station Trustee that the UHF (444.500) Repeater shall be configured and operated as RepeaterBook states both FCARC and RRVARC operate, with “Links: Full-time to the North Central Texas Connection (NCTC) System.”, except for temporary, emergency and/or other exigent reasons **or as published on the Club website**, and; be it;

Further resolved, the RRVARC BOD directs that updating Club RepeaterBook data shall be the responsibility of the Club Secretary; and be it;

Further resolved the Club Secretary shall use best practices to ensure the Club Station Trustee and other administrative types have the ability to ensure the Club RepeaterBook information is updated and remains current (establish multi-path redundancy).
